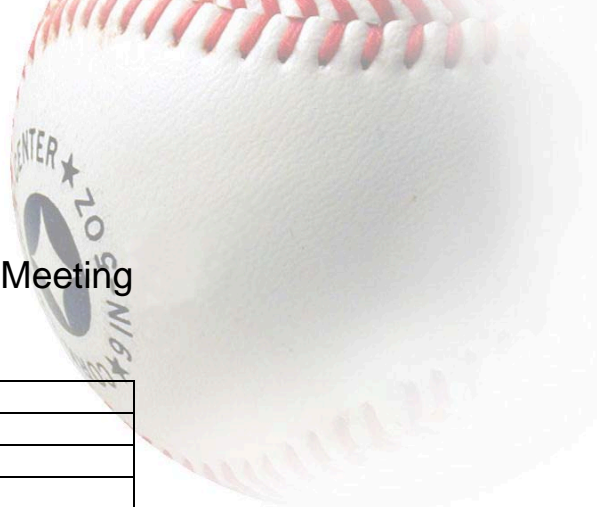

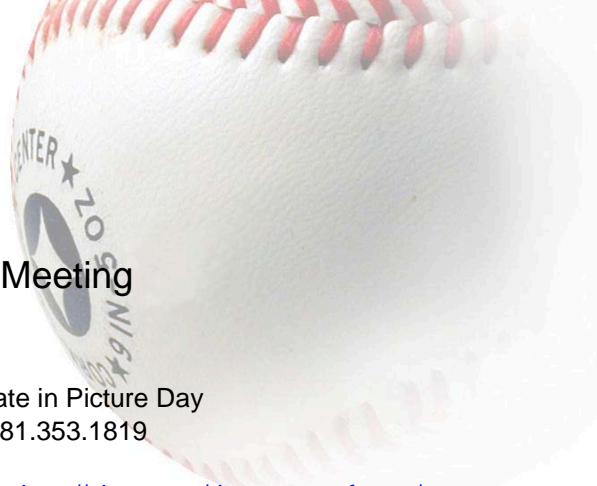

#### Scheduling

- Game schedule is due within the next 10 days
- Make-up Games – Friday evenings
- No late games the evening before TAKS Test days; 6:00 games are still played
- No games will be scheduled on weekdays during Klein ISD's Spring Break
- Rainouts – rainouts declared on website and through text messaging available on Nations Baseball website
- Reschedules – Requests require 7 day advanced written notice for consideration
  - Must be a qualified school activity AND prevent team from fielding 8 players

#### Team Parent Responsibilities

- Serve with your manager as the initial point of contact for your parents
- Coordinate with your manager for off-field activities
- Coordinate post-game snacks for your players – *kids play for snacks!!!*
- Coordinate yard sign and decal orders – **ONLY ONE** order form per team
- Provide a team roster/contact sheet to team's parents
- Ensure all parents sign Medical Release/Liability Form – **MUST** have at every team event
- Coordinate team's "booth duty" volunteers for SKSA Baseball Opening Day
- Your age group League Coordinator is the main point of contact
- **DO NOT REPORT ISSUES TO THE HOME PLATE CONCESSION STAND**

### Uniforms

- Standard issue for Spring season is: Jersey, Cap, Belt, and Socks. \*\*Pants are not provided\*\*
- Uniform Distribution Date: February 20, 2010
- **Candle Sale Fundraiser – Monies and order forms required for uniform pick-up**
  - \*\*\*Avoid issues at Uniform Pick-up – Reconcile candle sale monies with candle order forms to ensure accuracy before coming to Rothwood to pick up uniforms\*\*\*
  - Remind all parents of players selling candles that they are required to sell a minimum of 10 candles for \$10 each (Some players may be selling more than the minimum 10 candles)
  - Please verify that the player's first and last name, team name, and team mom or team manager's name is on the player's order form
  - Team Parent will turn in ALL of their team's candle order forms and monies at the 02/20/10 Uniform Distribution
  - SKSA will order the candles and kit each team's candles by player
  - It will take 3-4 additional weeks for SKSA to take delivery of candles
  - Team Parents will pick up the candles at Candle Distribution
  - Candle pick-up is tentatively scheduled for April 17; teams will be notified of any change
  - SKSA will return the player's original candle order form with their candles
  - There will only be **ONE** Candle Distribution. Team Parents need to make the appropriate arrangements for someone to pick up their team's candles
  - Players are responsible for delivering the candles to their customers
  - Any prizes the players win through the candle sale incentive program will be made available during Opening Day
  - Send all candle sale questions to [corporate.secretary@sksa.com](mailto:corporate.secretary@sksa.com)
- Teams **MUST** be in good standing before SKSA will release uniforms to the team
- Teams **MUST** bring the following items to the Uniform Distribution
  - Outstanding player registration fees (all players **MUST** be paid in full)
  - \$375 Sponsorship Fee
  - Players' candle sale money and order forms
  - Medical Release/Liability Form signed by all parents – SKSA will initial the form for verification

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## BASKET RAFFLE PROCEDURES

1. Baskets will be *RANDOMLY* selected and raffled. Winners will NOT have the option to choose.
2. All tickets are \$1 and will be sold individually to increase chances of winning.
3. There will be a minimum purchase required per Level:  
Level A - 1 ticket (blue); Level B - 3 tickets (green); Level C - 5 tickets (red); and Level D -10 tickets (black).
4. Level D tickets may be distributed among other Level D baskets at the bidder's discretion. Only Level D baskets can be bid on individually.
5. Bidders need not be present to win. Winners not present will be notified by phone. Pick-up dates will be scheduled for the following week and posted on the SKSA website. Baskets not picked up during these times will be donated elsewhere.
6. Baskets will be raffled beginning at 10:00 a.m. and every hour afterward. Level D baskets will not be raffled until the end of the day at 4:00 p.m.

**NOTE: We strongly encourage parents to browse the Booth *before* purchasing tickets. This will help to determine the correct number of tickets to purchase.**
