The 2012 SKSA Softball Season will begin the week of February 6, 2012. Reservations for the first season will be accepted up through the week before league start. Deposits are required to reserve a spot. Leagues are played at Collins Park (formerly Cypresswood Park) located off Cypresswood Drive in Spring, TX, between Kuykendahl and Stuebner Airline.

League Format: - All leagues will be 6 weeks of double headers (12 games)
- ASA Rules will apply
- Only ASA approved .52 core/300 compression, red-stitch softballs will be accepted

League Fees: \$ 375.00 (League Fee)
30.00 (ASA Sanction Fee - Paid Once Annually)
30.00 (Forfeiture Fee - Paid Once Annually - Non-Refundable)
\$ 435.00 (Payable to SKSA) plus umpires fees (see below)

\$100.00 Deposit Required Upon Registration to insure your spot. Only teams who have paid their deposits will be accepted on a first come-first served basis. FULL BALANCE OF LEAGUE FEES ARE DUE THE FIRST NIGHT OF SEASON - \$25.00 LATE CHARGE PER WEEK IMPOSED UNTIL PAID IN FULL! Pay your league fee in full prior to first night of play and receive a \$50.00 discount! Each consecutive league played-\$25.00 discount. Church teams-\$50.00 discount. Company Sponsored Teams-\$25.00 discount. \$25.00 fee on returned checks. WE ACCEPT MASTERCARD & VISA.

Umpire Fees: Umpire fees are not included in League Fees. Umpire fees are \$15.00 (two umpires) or \$11.00 (single umpire) per game and are payable in cash at the start of each game.

Mens C, D and REC Class - Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday nights
Mens Church League (C, D and REC Class) - Friday night
